

COVID-19 POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Dear BSAA Members,

We are excited to announce the pool will open on May 21, 2020 at 11 a.m. For our regular season!

In order to comply with CDC and state regulations and in hopes to provide a safe, fun environment to enjoy our pool services we will open with new rules and regulations.

1. **A LIMITED # of spots** - were measured and marked off for groups to use when at the pool. There are 17 spots with 6 feet of distance between each one. It will be first come first serve. Lifeguards will sign you in and note your time of arrival on the sign in sheet. **If all spots are full and other members are waiting for admission** – this RARELY happens at our small pool! - then we will ask members to limit their time to two hours. IF this happen lifeguards will remind patrons that have been there at least 2 hours – OTHERWISE you may stay as long as you wish!
2. We will use clips (red for taken, green for open) on the fence to show which spots are available and which spots are occupied. This will also help guards see what is and is not available.
3. Guards will show each family where their spot will be for their swim slot.
4. **NO GUESTS** - due to limited capacity, no guests are allowed at the pool at this time.
5. **SANITIZING** - We will be sanitizing bathrooms and common high touch areas every hour. There will also be sanitizing spray and wipes available for anyone to use who wants too. You may also request the guards to clean an area or item specifically for you as well. We want everyone to be safe!
6. **NO POOL FURNITURE** - We will open without the use of deck furniture and will require members to bring their own chairs.
7. **CALL AHEAD** - Members will be encouraged to call the pool before coming to make sure there is availability. You can call ahead 30 minutes before your arrival to reserve a spot.
8. **Umbrellas** - will be out for use, but members are not to move them. If they would like the umbrella relocated, they must ask a guard to do so. Umbrella poles will be wiped down in between each group.
9. **SLIDE & DIVING** - slide is CLOSED for now but the diving board will be OPEN.
10. **BATHROOMS** - will be available and routine cleaning will be performed by staff. Also, cleaning solution will be made available to any individuals or families who would like to clean prior to/after use.
11. Patrons are encouraged to maintain the 6 foot social distancing guidelines as mandated by the state. Guards will enforce all rules and will concentrate on maintaining safe pool practices inside and outside of the pool. Also, parents are asked to teach their children safe distancing practices and be sensitive to those around them.
12. **INDEPENDENT SWIMMER** – Age requirement change - Children must be 13 and over to attend the pool without an adult guardian this summer. We have changed the age limit from 9 to 13 due to the need for increased parental guidance.
13. **CONCESSIONS** - No concessions will be sold at this time. Feel free to bring your cooler and snacks but please clean up after yourself.
14. **PAYMENTS** – NO CASH will be availble at the pool to make change. If you'd like to make a payment in cash please bring exact change with the cash in an envelope & your name on it.
15. No loitering in front of the office.
16. **LOST & FOUND** - will have a lost and found. However, you will not be able to borrow goggles or floats from the lost and found at this time.
17. **RULES** - We will have a COVID rules sign hanging on the pool house wall (next to the Pool Rules) to remind us all of the new rules and regulations.

These rules are subject to change as the summer evolves. We expect continued guidance to be given by local and state authorities in the coming weeks. We are excited for warm summer days and relish the chance to see everyone!
